MEET OUR 2024 INSTRUCTORS



LIZ CARROLL, born to Irish parents, lives in Chicago. Her interest in fiddle playing was as natural as learning to walk. Her father and grandfather were both musicians. As a child, Liz was obviously exceptional and was encouraged toward classical training. By junior high, though, she knew classical violin was not her heartbeat. The first and, perhaps, greatest influencers were her father, Kevin Carroll, and her grandfather, Tom Cahill. She now includes many others on that list. Liz has been thinking lately of the path her musical life has taken, a road rich with travelling companions and inspiration from so many stops along the way. As a composer, her list of accolades, awards, and

achievements is long. She could easily set herself apart but has, instead, chosen the Irish way – we are all friends, none above the other, each on a journey. Liz embraces her part in that Irish traditional music heritage. To sit in class under her tutelage is an honor. You leave having gained so much more than you expected. We hope you will take this incredible opportunity to learn from Liz Carroll, a giant who inspires everyone with her "Irish smile," quick wit, and amazing talent.



KEVIN CRAWFORD is an Irish flute, tin whistle, and bodhran player born in England to Irish parents. The family moved to Co. Clare in his early 20's and quickly fell into the Irish traditional music

scene. He returns to GCC by popular demand. Kevin played an integral role in helping get GCC on its feet and set off in the right direction. Kevin began his performing journey in the early 80's and has gained international fame and respect. Over the past 40 years, he has worked with many of the greats and recorded many albums. He joined Lúnasa in 1997 and became their front man during live performances. Lúnasa continues to travel worldwide and just released an album, "Live In Kyoto," recorded in Japan. Kevin's teaching skills are legend and have been on display around the world, too. With his engaging personality, saturated with encouragement and attention to detail perfected by years of experience, have made him a renowned teacher and mentor.



ANNA COLLITON is a lively and inventive musician who has fast become one of America's leading exponents of the bodhrán. Based in New York City, she has shared the stage with Cherish the Ladies, Eileen

Ivers, Comas, The Paul McKenna Band, and many more. She was a sub for the bodhrán chair in the original company of the Broadway hit "Come From Away." She has performed and taught at many festivals across the country. As a teacher, she is dedicated to advancing the tradition of bodhrán playing. She inspires students to incorporate both the "old" and the "new" into their playing, emphasizing the importance of both personal style and ear training in traditional music. Anna currently performs with Eileen Ivers's new project The Brigideens and with the Boston-based traditional music group Ship in the Clouds. We are enormously excited to have her back at GCC in the classroom and on stage. Anna's teaching style is saturated with encouragement, depth, and experience. She is also a graphic artist who has been creating works for album covers, festivals, and others since 2012. We are especially grateful to Anna for working on our new GCC logo.


