
Planning for the 2025 Cruinniú continues. All the instructors are secured. Registration date will soon be announced. Watch here for more news on our path to June.

FACULTY CONNECTIONS A COLUMN DEDICATED TO CRUINNIÚ INSTRUCTOR NEWS AND

MICHAEL MCGOLDRICK will be joining our faculty at GCC for the first time in 2025. This is a rare opportunity to study flute with this highly influential musician. McGoldrick has been a prominent figure in the folk music scene since the early '90's and has a uniquely flowing and ornamented style. His playing draws heavily from many musical genres,

and includes the use of "blue notes" and other jazz influences while staying strongly anchored in the Irish tradition.

McGoldrick grew up in Manchester, which has a strong Irish heritage. He was exposed to traditional music from a young age

which had a significant role in shaping his musical style. In addition to playing flute, his low whistle, uilleann pipe, and bodhran playing are greatly admired.

Over the years, McGoldrick has been involved in various bands and numerous collaborations. He co-founded the influential band 'Flook', was an early member of Lúnasa, and also joined 'Capercaillie,' a Scottish folk band. He has worked with many artists including John McSherry, John McCusker, John Doyle, Kate Rusby, Mark Knopfler, John Carty, Usher's Island and Sharon Shannon among many others. McGoldrick has appeared on numerous recordings including several solo albums, and is the recipient of numerous accolades on the world music scene.



BRENDA CASTLES will be our first concertina instructor at the Gulf Coast Cruinniú. Brenda hails from Co. Meath and honed her concertina skills under the tutelage of Mícheál Ó'Raghallaigh. Castles is a seasoned performer, recording artist, and instructor currently based in Dublin (IRL) and New York City. She released her debut solo album "Indeedin You Needn't Bother" in December of 2016

and "The Light Side of the Tune" in 2021.

Brenda teaches around the world both at Irish music festivals and arts events, including the O'Flaherty Irish Music Retreat and the Catskills Irish Arts Week. She has been a performer in two Celtic Sojourn productions in the Boston area and was a member of the Green Fields of America collective with the late Mike Maloney. Notable recent performances include solo concerts at Temple Bar TradFest, Meath Beo, the Pipers Club, Earth Rising and the Concertina Festival in Ennis. Beyond her musical endeavors Brenda has delved into the realm of film, creating and producing the evocative short film "Plight of the Bumble Bee" with a traditionally inspired soundtrack of her own compositions.
