

Paul, he will be coming to us from Galway. Students with greater facility on the bodhran are encouraged to take this class. Paul is a highly experienced instructor, and this is a great opportunity to study with a nuanced and exceptional player. Paul McClure originally hails from Buncrana, Co. Donegal. Living in Galway for many years, he has become a sought after teacher, composer, arranger, and performer. Paul is a three-time All-Ireland winner on bodhrán and piano accordion. He has worked with many artists and bands and is currently performing with Altan. He has performed on numerous albums spanning genres from Irish traditional, contemporary folk, Scottish traditional, and electronic genres. McClure has taught numerous workshops and master classes throughout Ireland as well as performing both at home and abroad on tours and at festivals across the UK, France, Spain, Italy and Denmark. Paul has recently developed an online Patreon page where he delivers in-depth bodhrán tutorials, catering to all abilities and helping those who may not have access to a teacher to be able to learn and expand their knowledge and expertise in bodhrán playing.

us.David Howley was born in Galway and started his musical life at a very early age. From the age of 12, David really began to hone his craft in the local bars in Clare and Galway and joined every session possible. Playing guitar, banjo, and mandolin, David was quickly marked as a hugely talented singer and multi-instrumentalist being described as having "soul beyond his years." He is a celebrated Irish musician, vocalist, and educator who has performed with Grammy winners like The Chieftains, Mumford & Sons, and Bela Fleck.

As a co-founder and lead songwriter of We Banjo 3, David helped elevate the band to international success, with their seven albums receiving numerous accolades, including a Billboard Chart World #1 and the Songlines Top of the World Award. He is also a three-time All-Ireland champion, a testament to his mastery. In addition to his extensive touring and recording career, David is passionate about teaching and sharing his craft. He regularly instructs at prestigious music programs such as the O'Flaherty Irish Music Retreat and the Milwaukee Irish Fest Summer School. His teaching connects traditional Irish music with students across the globe, fostering a new generation of musicians.
