Requirement to Assist During Event

All of our scholarship students or, if considered too young, their parents or guardians are asked to volunteer 3 hours over the course of GCC to assist the retreat in support of our program. Examples of such assistance include working as a classroom/instructor liaison, working in the Cruinniú office, at the sales table during evening concerts, or helping set up the retreat or helping tear down when it is over. You will be contacted prior to the retreat, and a schedule will be arranged. Event assistance will not interfere with the student's class schedule. Under age 18 students must have a parent or guardian accompany the student for the volunteer duties.
